Police Reserve Applicant Criteria:

- Must be 18 years of age
- Be a United States citizen
- Possess a valid Minnesota driver's license have a good driving record
- Possess a high school diploma or equivalent
- Ability to communicate orally and in writing
- Be in good physical and mental health without any disabilities restricting body functions.
- Pass an oral interview and review board
- Submit to a criminal history and background check
- Complete the reserve academy and attend training we provide
- Successfully complete a probationary period

Must also meet department tattoo and uniform policy and fill out an employment application.
